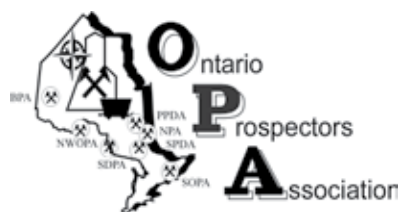

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Explorers and discoverers of minerals in Ontario go back to pre-European presence. Over time, the demand for minerals has grown, with various commodities being targeted, some being fleeting and others constant. Silver, uranium and iron ore were once exploration and development powerhouses. These have diminished as primary targets, with gold and copper being provincial and world consistencies. Now we have added the supposed critical mineral boom. Critical metals have become a political focus, with countries and unions setting up affiliations and partnerships to procure secure sources.

Ontario definitely has the rocks to potentially host the needed critical minerals, but we must rely on the prospectors and junior companies to lead the way! Issues in success have not changed over time, including prospectors with dreams, land access, geological knowledge (interpretation), world demand and the ability to raise risk capital.

The two greatest issues at present are prospectors' and junior companies' knowledge of the geological environments—where and how the required critical minerals occur—and

the risk capital needed to locate them. At present, the Ontario government is trumpeting the province as a powerhouse of critical metal deposits, which is definitely a possibility, but prospectors and explorers need to find and define them. Another huge issue is the ability to raise risk capital needed to meet the Ontario government's proficiencies. Raising funds for any project at present is hampered by the dismal stock prices of junior explorers. This is a worldwide issue that is crippling Ontario exploration.

Solutions for prospectors and explorers need to be assisted by a strong Ontario Ministry of Mines focused on exploration to locate and define the critical mineral wealth.

This next year could be a very prosperous year for prospectors, adding critical metals to gold targets. One thing that will endure is the allure of the gold project. Gold, like other commodities, has been constant and has made Ontario a powerhouse over the centuries.

We need to step up to become a powerhouse globally in critical minerals! Get out and take advantage of the wealth in our backyard! Critical metals coupled with gold are there to be found!

ABOUT THE OPA

The Ontario Prospectors Association (OPA) is a not-for-profit organization that serves as the voice for the mineral exploration community.

The OPA continually engages with the government to positively influence policy. Currently, at the provincial level, the OPA contributes to the Government of Ontario's Mining Working Group, and pursues other issue-specific lobbying and engagement.

Key issues the OPA is currently focused on includes:

1. Increasing the provincial flow through incentives to be competitive with other provinces;
2. Creation of a permanent exploration rebate program, following the Junior Exploration Assistance Program (JEAP) that the OPA successfully delivered several years ago. JEAP led to 61 projects attracting financing, including work that led to Great Bear Resources' discovery on their Dixie Lake project;
3. Meeting on a two-to three-week basis with land managers and staff at the Ministry of Mines to improve the Mining Land Administration System (MLAS);
4. Participating in the Minister of Mines, Mining Working Group;
5. Collaborating with other provincial and national associations through the Canadian Mineral Industry Federation;
6. Lobbying to streamline the plans and permits system;

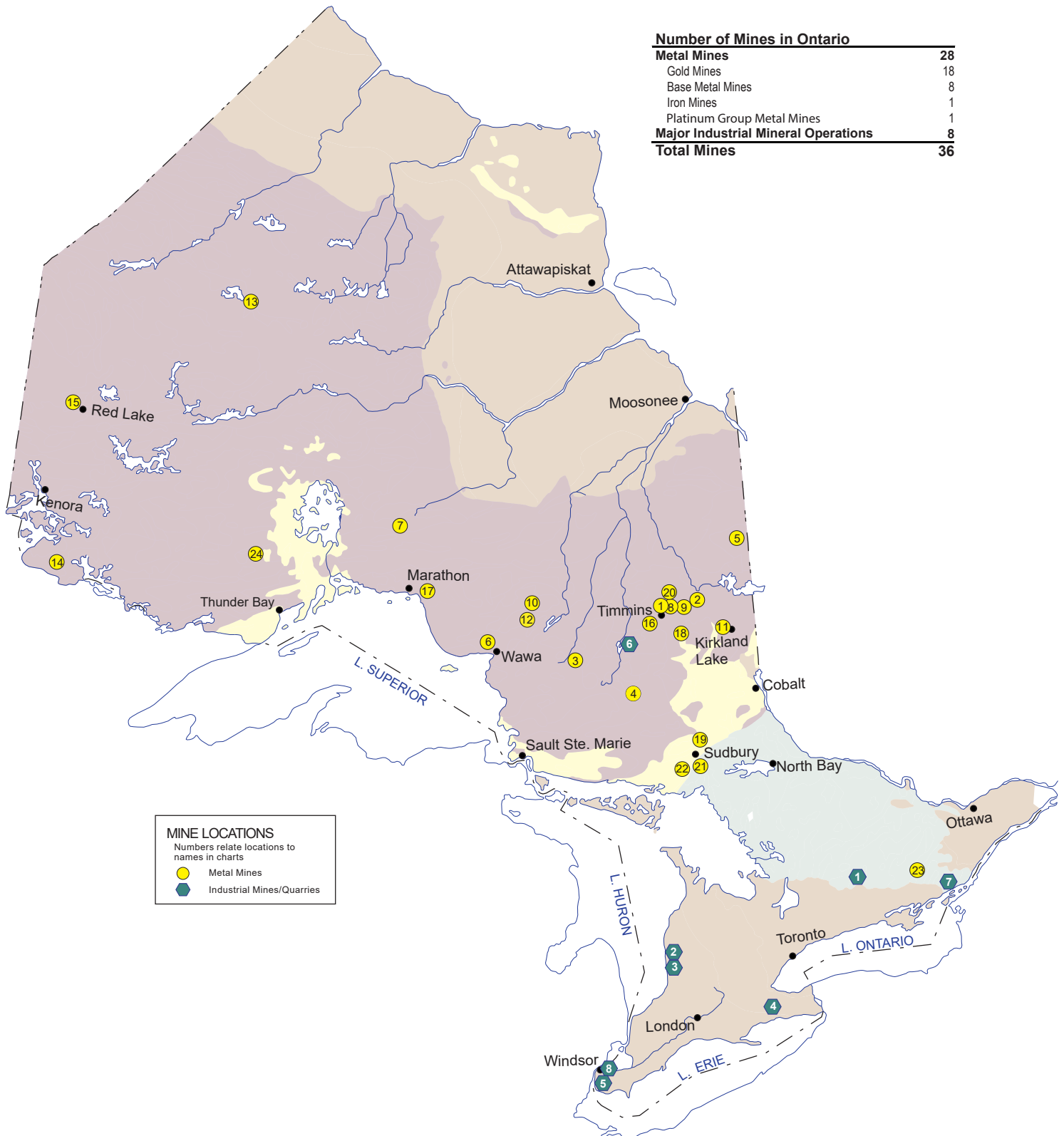

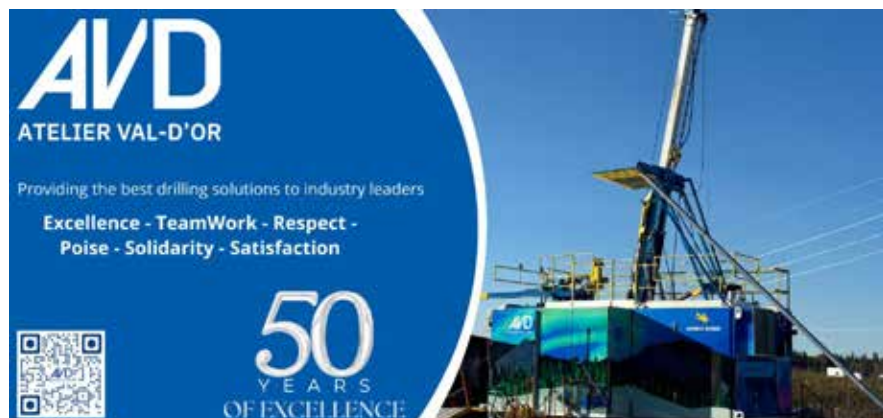

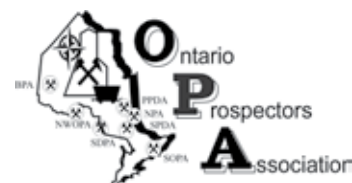
